Overview

The Lenoir-Rhyne Football Team returns to play after a week off to face UNC Pembroke on the road Saturday at 4:00 p.m., in Pembroke, N.C., at Grace P. Johnson Stadium.

Lenoir-Rhyne is 3-4 on the year while UNC Pembroke is 1-6.

The Bears downed Limestone by a 35-7 score on Saturday, October 14, in Gaffney, S.C., while UNC Pembroke fell to Concord on the road last Saturday by a 31-22 score.

These two teams met for the first time ever last year with the Braves prevailing by a 36-20 score on Saturday, October 8, in Hickory, N.C.

UNC Pembroke went 10-2 last year, advanced to the Second Round of the NCAA Division II Playoffs and finished the year ranked No. 13 in the nation.

The Braves are also playing at home for the first time since Saturday, September 23.

Lenoir-Rhyne is looking to climb back to .500 on the year for the first time since starting the season with a 1-1 mark.

Bear Facts

- Lenoir-Rhyne sophomore defensive back Landon Scott (Moultrie, Ga.) was named the AstroTurf SAC Defensive Player Of The Week on October 16 in the Bears' 35-7 victory over Limestone two Saturdays ago. Scott returned an interception 95 yards for a score late in the first quarter which proved to be the difference-maker.
- In addition, Scott was named the Southside Power & Fitness Ronnie Lott Heavy Hitter winner for the Saints' contest as well.
- Lenoir-Rhyne is looking to win consecutive games for the first time since the 2015 campaign. The Bears are also 2-1 on the road this year.

Mike Kellar Head Football Coach Lenoir-Rhyne University

Mike Kellar is beginning his second year as Head Football Coach at LR in 2017.

Kellar comes to Lenoir-Rhyne after serving as the Head Football Coach at California University (Pa.) (2012-15).

In four years as head coach, Kellar led the Vulcans to a 31-12 record while playing ten nationally-ranked teams.

California featured six All-Americans in that span, including offensive lineman Eric Kush, who became the second Vulcans player in recent years to be selected in the NFL Draft.

Prior to taking the top spot for the Vulcans, Kellar was the team's offensive coordinator for one year (2011).

During the 2011 season, Kellar worked with the most prolific passing offense in school history. Quarterback Peter Lalich broke the single-season school records for attempts, completions and passing yards, averaging nearly 300 yards per game.

Kellar's five-year stint at the California, Pa., school (2011-15) was the second of two five-year tenures with the Vulcans.

Before returning to California, Kellar guided Concord University (W.Va.) to a 14-8 record as head coach. Prior to his arrival, the Mountain Lions managed only one win in the previous two years and hadn't posted a winning season since 1998.

In 2010, Kellar led Concord to an 8-3 overall record to mark the first eight-win season for the program since it joined NCAA Division II in 1993.

Under his guidance, the Mountain Lions featured one of the most balanced offenses in the WVIAC in 2010, ranking second in passing and total offense. Concord also ranked fourth in the country by averaging almost 500 yards of offense per game.

Kellar was offensive coordinator at California (2004-08) for five seasons during his first stint the Pennsylvania school.

In 2004 and 2005, he coached the PSAC West Offensive Player of the Year in running back Antoine Bagwell. In 2005, the Vulcans averaged over 460 yards of total offense and scored over 40 points per game.

After California led the PSAC in total offense and rushing offense in 2006, Kellar directed a record-setting offense during the historic 2007 season. The Vulcans rushed for nearly 2,900 yards and totaled over 5,000 yards of offense for the first time in school history.

The following year (2008), California won its first PSAC Championship since 1984 and shattered the single-season school record with over 6,000 yards of total offense.

In all but one of Kellar's ten years with the program, the Vulcans averaged over 30 points per game. His Vulcans' offenses have helped seven players earn All-America status.

In 2002 and 2003, Kellar served as the offensive coordinator at Northern Michigan University.

Under Kellar, the Wildcats set school records for passing attempts, completions and yards in 2002 before finishing second in the league in total offense and passing yards in 2003.

Kellar began his coaching career at his alma mater, Fairmont State University, where he would serve for eight years as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach.

Kellar was part of two Falcon squads who captured a pair of West Virginia Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WVIAC) Championships.

As a collegiate player, Kellar was the starting quarterback for Glenville State (W.Va.) before transferring to Fairmont State (W.Va.).

Kellar's passion for football began with his own success as a student-athlete.

He earned his undergraduate degree in liberal arts from Fairmont State before receiving his master's degree in safety management from West Virginia University.

A native of West Virginia, Kellar and his wife, Melissa, have four children: Diedra, Jarrod, Anthony and Jacob.

STATS OF THE GAME:

- Lenoir-Rhyne rushed 50 times for 199 yards and was led by freshman running back **Xzavion Huff** (Maiden, N.C.) and sophomore tailback **Nelson Brown** (Salisbury, Md.) with 85 and 78 yards, respectively. Huff scored on a 39-yard touchdown run while Brown scored twice in the win.
- LR sophomore safety **Landon Scott** (Moultrie, Ga.) returned an interception 95 yards for a score late in the first quarter: the longest by a Bears player since All-American Michael Green returned a pick 100 yards to pay dirt in a playoff game on November 17, 2012, against Fort Valley State. Scott finished with two interceptions for 137 yards.
- Lenoir-Rhyne sophomore tight end **Sam Camargo** (Kissimmee, Fla.) caught his team-leading fifth touchdown of the season: a 16-yarder in the second quarter.
- Lenoir-Rhyne sophomore linebacker **Quentin Hayes** (Powder Springs, Ga.) was a star on defense, finishing with nine tackles, an interception, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery.
- Limestone's Jerko'ya Patton (Charlotte, N.C.) scored the lone touchdown of the game for the Saints in the second quarter on a 38-yard run.

BEYOND THE BOX SCORE:

- Lenoir-Rhyne is 2-1 on the road this year and held an opponent to seven points for the second time this fall.
- LR picked off four passes for the first time since 2012.

UP NEXT:

Lenoir-Rhyne will not play again until Saturday, October 28, against UNC Pembroke in Pembroke, N.C., beginning at 4:00 p.m. Limestone travels to Newberry, S.C., to take on Newberry next Saturday at 4:00 p.m.

Nelson Brown (RB)

Rushed for a season-high 256 yards against Tusculum (Sept. 30) ... Ranks second in the league in rushing (112.3 ypg) in 2017 ... Last year, led the Bears with 902 yards on the ground and six scores ... Second-Team All-SAC ... Rushed for 261 and 200 yards, respectively, last year in wins over Tusculum (Sept. 17, 2016) and Carson-Newman (Oct. 1, 2016).

Sherrod Williams (LB)

Ranks second on the squad in tackles with 47 this fall ... Last year, finished third in tackles (68) in addition to three forced fumbles and two fumble recoveries.

Kyle Dugger (DB)

Named the Ronnie Lott Heavy Hitter Award winner (Aug. 31 vs. West Alabama) in the season opener ... 2015 SAC Defensive Freshman of the Year ... Scored three touchdowns - blocked field goal return, blocked punt return and a fumble return - two years ago in addition to 43 tackles ... Leads the team in tackles this year with 53.

Sam Camargo (TE)

Leads the team with five touchdowns so far this year ... Caught two six weeks ago against Mars Hill (Sept. 16) ... Has 10 catches for 85 yards total.

Jarrod Kellar (QB)

Threw for 289 yards and four scores - the most touchdown passes by a Bear since 2001 - six weeks ago against Mars Hill ... Has 952 yards passing and nine touchdowns so far this fall ... Second year starting at quarterback.

T.J. Smith (WR)

Leads the team with 20 receptions for 264 yards and two scores so far this year.
